

SHEBOYGAN CHRISTIAN SCHOOL HOT LUNCH PROGRAM – ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Hot Lunch will begin on Tuesday, August 21, 2018 at the Elementary School Campus.

Hot lunch will be served Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday at the elementary school each week. On occasion this schedule may be modified to accommodate shortened school weeks or unforeseen conflicts. Examples: If there is no school scheduled on a Monday, lunch will be served Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday.

A lunch meal includes a main entrée, side item, salad bar with fresh fruit, veggies, cheeses, pasta salads, yogurts, pudding, etc. and a dessert. When the student has completed their first portions, they may go back to the salad bar for additional food if they wish.

The meal cost is \$3.50 (subject to change without notice).

Tickets are purchased with either 6 or 12 meal punches, quarterly or yearly.

There is no refund for unused tickets/punches.

Tickets are purchased in the school office during office hours.

Please order tickets in advance for students. Do not wait until your child is completely out of “punches” before purchasing another ticket.

Students in 5K-5th grades will place their ticket in a basket when they enter the hot lunch line. The tickets will be punched and returned to the classroom teacher for distribution before the next hot lunch day. Parents and students will be responsible to keep track of how many “punches” remain on the child’s ticket. Parents may always check with the classroom teacher as to the status of the child’s meal ticket. If a student in 5K – 5th grades does not have a lunch ticket or a sack lunch, parents will be contacted to bring a lunch to school.

Students in Middle School will be completely responsible for their tickets. As they enter the hot lunch line, their ticket will be “punched” as they receive hot lunch. The ticket will be immediately returned to the students. The students and parents will need to keep track of how many “punches” remain on the ticket and make purchases as needed. If a student does not have a lunch ticket he/she will not be served hot lunch except for the three-day grace plan. We will give a three-day grace to a middle school student if he/she forgets or loses their ticket. The next day, the student will need to have the ticket and it will be punched for the past meals taken OR the student will need to purchase a new ticket. If tickets are lost, students will need to pay a 50 cent replacement fee.

Sharing hot lunch food with other students who did not order hot lunch is forbidden. Out of fairness to all families and to keep the hot lunch program running cost effectively, sharing food is not allowed.
