The 2020 One Walk for Christian Education

Celebrating 50 years of faithful footsteps for Christian Education

Dear SCS Community,

That's right! This is the 50th year of this walk taking place, and we aren't planning to let anything stop us from making this the best year ever! The event this year may be a little different than in the past but the purpose will remain the same: to have the students raise funds to support Christian Education in Sheboygan County!

This letter is to inform you, the parents, as to how this year's event will look. We recognize that in light of Covid-19, we need to be doing all we can to allow the students to seek pledges and to walk in the safest manner possible. We as a committee will be doing just that. There will be more information to come soon in the weeks ahead and we will be posting several videos on the event to keep parents, students, and donors informed.

The event will take place on September 24, 2020. This is a Thursday this year rather than the usual Friday. Friday is no school due to in-service.

Registration: It's now ONLINE! Yes, we have now put the registration forms online. Click [HERE](#) to complete your registration today. It takes less than 1 minute to fill out. Each student needs to have their own registration form where you can select the shirt size. At the end, you will need to sign using your mouse or finger. Please note that all students (3k-12th grade) are welcome to participate in fundraising and walking. We do ask that any students 3k-3rd grade are accompanied by an adult that day.

Registration will be due by 9/15 to be guaranteed a shirt. Additional paper registration forms are at each office in the event that you cannot utilize the online registration properly.

Route: This year, the route remains the same. However, now middle school and high school students will begin walking at 1:00pm from the High School to the Elementary School (6 miles) and then the elementary school students will join them at 3:30pm to walk to the finish at South Pier Parlor (4 miles). There will be ice cream served at South Pier Parlor but we will not be able to share a meal together. Awards will be presented at the finish as well. Parents should be prepared to pick up their students by 5:30pm. We will be providing shuttles for the HS students to get back to their cars.

Prizes: More information to come soon but we will have great prizes this year. And I mean great! Top 3 fundraisers overall will each receive a nice prize (that of the electronic nature). Top fundraiser in each class will receive a \$20 scrip gift card of their choice and then the top class in \$ raised and the classes with 100% participation will receive pizza parties. This year, we will also be judging student pledge request videos and reward the best video. Details on that is in the next section.

Donations: We have added a portal to the website for donors to give easily and with the option of using a credit card. Click [HERE](#) to view our “Donate Now” portal. Donations can begin TODAY! Donors may select “OneWalk” from the dropdown, and can either give to the One Walk in general, or they will be able to name any and all students to get credit for the donation. We will also be giving each student a packet of donor cards shortly as we have in the past for those who prefer to safely seek face to face donation requests. Lastly, we recognize that many of our donors in the community may not be able to see students or talk to students face to face at this time. To promote safety but still have the ability to seek donations, we are asking all students to video themselves requesting support. Send it to anyone you know! It’s just a click of a button. We had proof last year from one student that this works tremendously! We will be posting ideas on how to make this video so students and parents please watch for this. On top of that, students who submit their pledge request videos to community@sheboyganchristian.com will be entered to win a \$100 Amazon gift card for most creative video!

Let’s not allow Covid-19 to keep us from making this great event happen! Let’s make 2020 and our 50th One Walk the best year ever! We have no idea what school fundraising events will be able to be held this year. This is an event that we can do with little personal contact with the outside community and we can be sure the students walk in a safe and responsible manner.
